

*Addendum Ben cao gang mu, Vol. IV, p. 906 bottom:*

*Zhou hou fang* states: “Whenever someone is struck by *ye ge* poison and cannot open the mouth, take a large bamboo tube with holes at its nodes. Attach the end [of the tube] to his two flanks and the navel and fill cold water into the tube. Frequently replace the water [that has run out through the holes]. After a short while [the person] opens the mouth. Then he can be given medication to resolve [the poison]. The only way [to rescue him is to let him] drink large amounts of [the following liquids]. *Glycyrrhiza* [root] juice, human feces juice, and the blood of a white duck or goose, whose head has just been chopped off, that is dripped into [the patient’s] mouth. Or force-feed him with sheep blood.” The *Ling nan wei sheng fang* states: “Immediately grind a chicken egg that is not yet fully hatched to a pulp, mix it with sesame oil and force-feed it [to the patient]. If he vomits the poisonous item, he will survive. If this [rescue] is delayed, he dies.”
